Iceland Trip 19th October to 23rd October 2017

Dear parents,

We are delighted to offer your son the exciting opportunity to go on a five day trip to **Iceland in October 2017**. Iceland has become known as 'the land of ice and fire' because of its glaciers and volcanoes which have carved out dramatic natural landforms. Students will be able to experience the real awe and wonder of the physical geography of Iceland first hand.

Some of the highlights of the trip will be:

- Swimming in the blue lagoon geothermal lake
- A guided glacier walk
- Visiting Gullfoss, the Golden Waterfall
- Walking through a rift valley in Thingvellir National Park

The trip will depart on **Thursday 19th October** which is the first day of half term and return on **Monday 23rd October**. The Iceland trip will be open to students from the current Upper Middles, 4ths and 5ths year groups. Non-geography students are also welcome to participate.

The cost of the trip will be approximately £1050 including flights, hotel accommodation, meals, entrance fees and bus transfers to the airport. Places will be allocated on a first come first served basis.
