

Fees and Charges 2024/25

Tuition fees

Fees are payable either monthly by direct debit or termly (due not later than the first day of each term).

The tuition fee includes tuition, text books and external exam entry charges for IGCSE in Year 11 and the International Baccalaureate/A levels in Year 13.

All applicants at the 11+ and 16+ entry points to the school must pay a £50 (£60 including VAT) registration fee to cover administrative costs. For applicants at other entry points the registration fee is £150 (£180 including VAT). A deposit of £400 is payable on acceptance of a place and is refunded when a pupil leaves the school, less any unpaid fees and charges.

Catering charges

Catering is charged on a termly basis in advance based on the number of catering days in the coming term. No reduction is provided for fewer than five consecutive absences due to ill health.

All pupils in Shells (Year 7) are required to participate in the lunch system and the catering charge will be added to the tuition fee in the first year.

Pupils in Removes (Year 8) to Fifths (Year 11) can either opt in or out of the catering system on a termly basis and these charges are paid separately from the tuition fee through SchoolComms as part of the supplementary charges system.

Miscellaneous charges

From time to time, pupils will have the opportunity to take part in various local educational trips, for example theatre trips or local geography and history field trips. An appropriate charge will be made to cover the cost of admission and transport where applicable.

Compulsory school trips

There are two compulsory trips that boys must attend in their first two years in the school. Prices for the 2023/24 year, as an indication of cost, are provided below.

Shells Camping trip (June)	Compulsory for all Shells	£285
Removes Week (May)	Compulsory for all Removes	£480

As boys get older, they will be required to participate in Biology and Geography field trips if they choose these subjects for their public exams and these trips will also be compulsory.

Boys choosing to take part in the Combined Cadet Force in the Fourths and above will also have to pay an annual subscription of £140 and this will cover all CCF Friday afternoon activities.

Discounts and financial assistance

A tuition fee sibling discount of 25% is available for the third and subsequent child(ren) currently attending either this school or King Edward VI High School for Girls where parents are paying full fees for three or more siblings from the same immediate family.
